Major Influences

- Reentry Services now part of Probation Budget
- State Funding/Block Grant has remained stable-no decrease in funding
- FTE's within the department remain stable
- Workload remains fairly stable

Future Unknowns

Raise the Age Legislation

- Raising the age of criminal responsibility from age 16 to age 18
- Several versions of draft legislation have been created but have not garnered support
- The versions drafted thus far would result in all 16 and 17 year olds being issued a JD appearance ticket requiring an appearance at Probation for possible Diversion Services
- 100% funding for additional Probation workload was promised in most recent version
