

**Education:** provides prevention education to youth, community members, college students and professionals throughout the county.






# Better Housing for Tompkins County






## Cancer Resource Center

Provides information, support and community for people who have been affected by cancer.






# Lifelong






## Multicultural Resource Center

Engages in cultural and systemic transformation by building with our communities to eliminate barriers to racial justice, cultural dignity, equity and inclusion, and indigenous rights.



Affirms, empowers, and fosters the development of self pride among the African American citizens of greater Ithaca, through forums and activities in education, recreation, political and social awareness.





- A Place to Stay: transitional, supportive housing for homeless single women






Three-year funding to support agency efforts through the Continuum of Care (CoC) to provide housing for those experiencing homelessness.




## **Over-Target Request:**

- To restore CDRC county funding to near previous levels
- To serve as a local match required for state funding. NYS Unified Court System is restoring funding for mediation centers that took significant cuts in 2011. CDRC will receive funding in 2018 based on its ability to secure a local match.
- No other agency is currently equipped to meet the state's mandate to provide mediation services.

## Ithaca Health Alliance/Free Clinic

Facilitates access to health care for all with a focus on the needs of the uninsured and under-insured by providing free integrated medical care and medically related support services through the operation of the Ithaca Free Clinic.


To support an increase in rent and staff salaries.

Leads low-income women to the pathway out of poverty by providing individualized career counseling and training, and removing barriers to become job ready and find employment.
