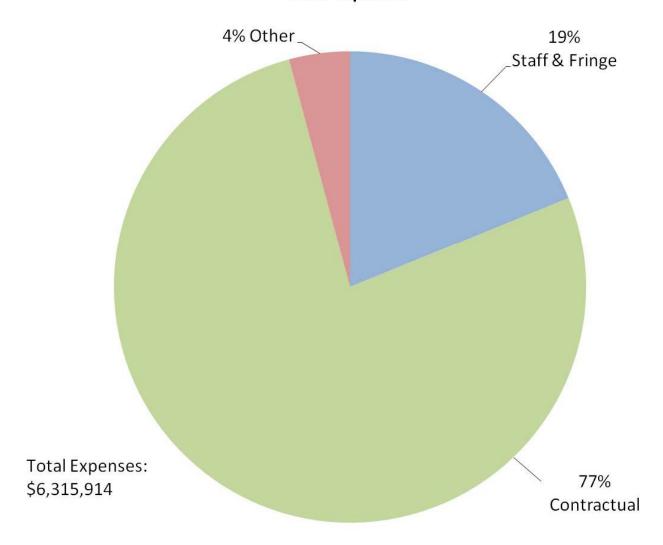

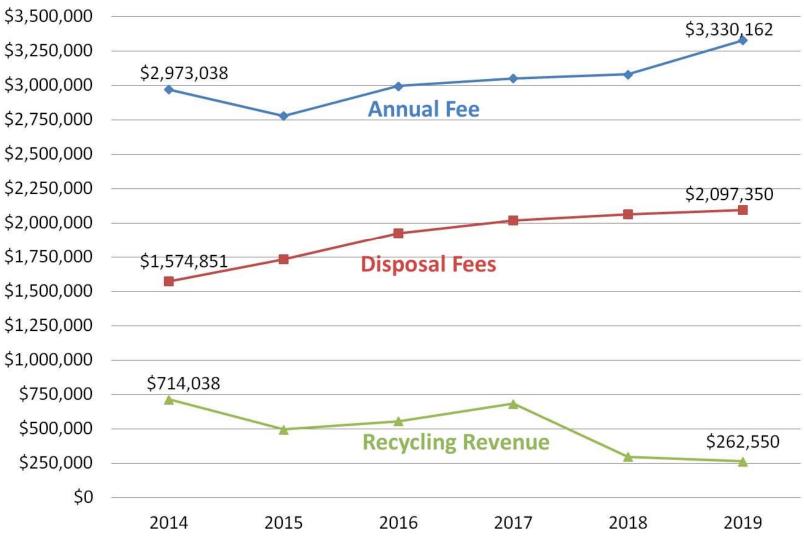
Major Influences

- Develop draft RFP for recycling contract

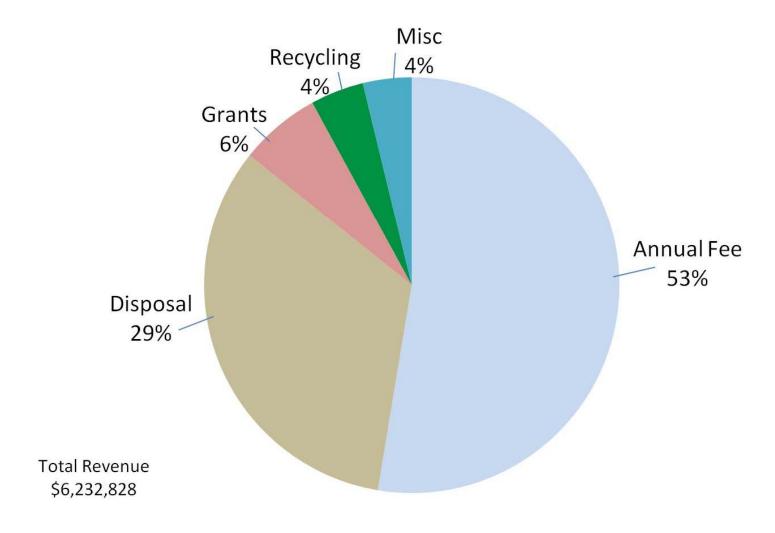
Recycling & Materials Management 2019 Expenses



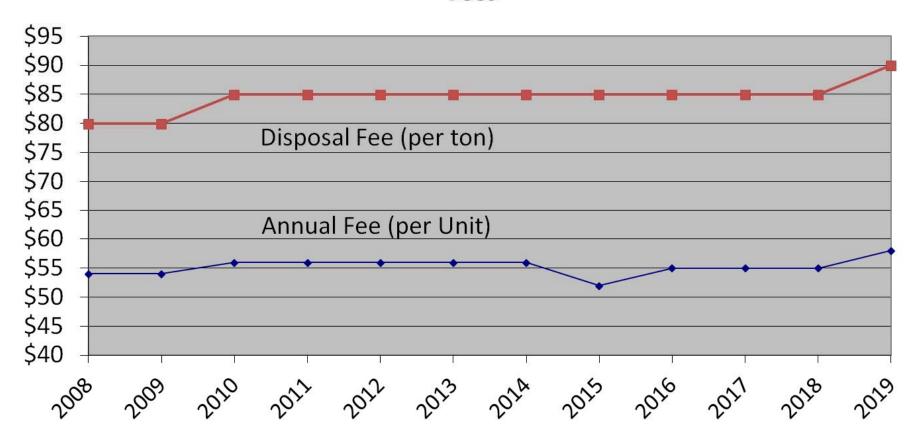
Recycling & Materials Management Major Revenue Sources
