Re: Real Property Tax Exemptions Renewal Forms in the Mail

On November 3, 2010, the Tompkins County Department of Assessment will be mailing renewal applications for the following exemptions: Disability, Clergy and Agricultural.

Renewal applications for the Disability and Clergy Exemptions are due no later than March 1, 2011. Renewal applications for Agricultural Exemption are due April 1, 2011.

Renewal applications for Senior Citizens will be mailed out before the end of November.

Any new exemption applications (including any new Agricultural Building Exemptions, Business Improvement Exemptions and Capital Improvements to Residential Properties – City of Ithaca only) must be filed by **March 1, 2011** as well.
