Re: **Data Verification for Annual Reassessment Program**

As a component in the six year plan of the Annual Reassessment Program, the Tompkins County Department of Assessment is conducting a parcel-by-parcel data verification of all real property in the County from the road right of way.

The members of the professional appraisal staff will be traveling in county owned vehicles with a County insignia on the car window and official license plate. They will be reviewing the correctness of the existing data, and taking photos of the properties in order to update the assessment records.
