VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Mark in pen or pencil.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot make a cross X mark or a check ✓ mark in one of the squares contained in the box setting forth such resolution.
3. To vote for a candidate whose name is NOT imprinted on this ballot write the name in the blank space at the bottom of the column under the title of the office.
4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting squares or blank spaces provided for voting will void this entire ballot.

HOW TO RETURN ABSENTEE BALLOT

1. After marking the ballot, fold such ballot and enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.
2. Fill in the blanks in the statement and sign your name.
3. The ballot of the absentee voter must be received by the Board of Inspectors of Elections not later than the closing of the polls, 9:00 PM, on village election day.
