What is an enhanced driver license (EDL)?

If you are a US citizen and NYS resident, you can apply for a NYS Enhanced Driver License (EDL) that can be used instead of a passport to return to the US by land or sea from Canada, Mexico and some countries in the Caribbean. An EDL is not acceptable for air travel between these countries. A NYS EDL is compliant with the Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI).

How do I apply for an EDL?

You must apply for an EDL at a [DMV office](#) and provide [proof of your identity, U.S. citizenship, NYS residency and age \(date of birth\)](#).

You will also need:

- a completed [Application for Enhanced Driver License or Non-Driver ID Card](#) (MV-44EDL)
- payment for the fees

Is there an additional fee for an enhanced driver license?

The additional fee for an enhanced driver licensed (EDL) or enhanced non-driver ID card (ENDID) is \$30.00. The is added to the other fees for the driver license or non-driver ID transaction.
