****Amendment****

FTA Tables Sect. 5307 – Mobility Management-Way2Go

The Planning and Policy Committees of the Ithaca-Tompkins County Transportation Council (ITCTC) approved an amendment to the 2014-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on **June 10, 2014**, during a regularly scheduled meeting. The action on the 2014-2018 TIP and the current State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) affects one project as described below and in the attached tables.

Description:

Tompkins County has requested that the ITCTC approve a 2014-18 TIP/STIP Amendment for FFY 2014 to add a new project, *Mobility Management – Way2Go Project* (PIN: 382828), with total funding of \$406,205. This action will enable the Federal funds to be obligated in Tompkins County's 2014 Section 5307 grant application. The new project will be added to the Sect.5307 Table of the Federal Transit Administration tables in the 2014-18 TIP.

New York State Department of Transportation, by letter dated Feb 15, 2014, awarded \$2,265,804 in Federal Transit Administration Section 5311 Rural Formula funds to Tompkins County. The grant award included \$324,964 Federal funding, (\$406,205 Total), for *Mobility Management – Way2Go*. The funding will enable the Way2Go community mobility education project to operate in 2015 and 2016. The Section 5311 funding will be transferred to the Section 5307 Urban Formula program in the application process for the 2014 Section 5307 grant, as authorized by Tompkins County Resolution 100 of 2014, (June 3, 2014).

The proposed amendment to the 2014-2018 TIP and the STIP is shown in the attached table. The table show the project will appear in the TIP and STIP. The TIP and STIP will remain fiscally constrained.
