Project 1: <i>Green Job-Skills Training Intern</i>			
Project Description: Finger Lakes ReUse has a brand-new green job-skills training program beginning in January 2013. Trainees will work with our deconstruction team to salvage buildings or with our eCenter team to refurbish computers for reuse, preserving materials while gaining job readiness. We will be developing curriculum for this program and recruiting program participants during fall 2012.			
Sustainability Intern's Role: We are seeking an intern to assist with developing and implementing this green job-skills training program. The intern will support curriculum development, assist with outreach to local human service agencies, and provide other program support as needed, including assisting with hands-on instruction in the spring 2013 semester and summer.			
Skills or Education Required: Excellent organization and communication skills, familiarity with computer hardware repair and basic construction skills a plus, but we are willing to train.			
Total Project Hours or Weekly Time Commitment: 10-15 hours/week			
Internship Duration (check all that apply): Spring Semester Fall Semester Summer - yes to all three!			
Intern Workspace: This Intern will work with staff supervision at Finger Lakes ReUse and at job sites.			
Funding: This project will be a work-study (paid) position. We have work-study arrangements with Cornell University and Ithaca College, and expect to have one with Tompkins Cortland Community College beginning Fall 2012. We will be able to provide a work-study position at \$12.50/hr to students at any of these three institutions, if arrangements are made early enough in the semester, and could offer the position as a volunteer one to students without work-study funding.
