This program is:

-  For those with little to no previous experience in the construction trades
-  A rigorous 10-week program to prepare students for construction jobs in residential, commercial and highway construction
-  To assist students to gain entry into these skilled jobs by scoring higher on aptitude tests

Participants must:

-  Attend classes two full days per week
-  Be 18 years of age or older
-  **Be Drug Free**
 - Have reliable transportation
-  Have a High School Diploma or GED
-  Be physically able to perform construction work, which is demanding, involving lifting, standing walking, and repeated squatting and bending
-  **Be prepared to work indoors and outdoors, in any weather conditions**

Other Expectations include:

-  Reporting for work on a regular basis and on time
-  Working under the direction of a journeyman or journeywoman on the job site
-  Attending classes and training
-  Completing the apprenticeship program
-  Abiding by the rules of the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee

Classes will begin February 17, 2015

This training program is scheduled to be 10 weeks in length starting on February 17, 2015 and running until Thursday, April 23, 2015. Classes will be every Tuesday and Thursday for 8 hours each day. As these classes cannot be repeated or duplicated, you will be expected to attend each scheduled training day to graduate from the program.
