SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM-WIB FUNDED

Ms. Tabor reported that the IYB have served a total of 56 youth with SYEP funds and has a total of 50 worksites hosting youth.

Ms. Bellis reported that they have served a total of 63 youth with SYEP funds.

SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT – OTHER AGENICES, MUNICIPALITIES

Ms. Schoffel reported that approximately 90 youth participated through CCE Rural Youth Program and Ms. Tabor reported that the IYB served 87 Youth with their Municipal Jobs Program and Target Jobs. The group discussed aggregating the numbers and looking at how all communities are being served.

EXTENSION OF EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING CONTRACT TO OPERATE WIA YOUTH THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012

Ms. Mattick reported that the Performance and Evaluation Committee is recommending that the Youth Employment Council extend the OET Contract to operate the WIA Youth Program to June 30, 2012. The 2009 RFP was for a two-year period with the option to extend the contract for up to one year. The recommendation is that we extend it for 9 months with a new RFP to be issued in early 2012. The current contract expires September 30, 2011. It was moved by Ms. Schoffel, seconded by Ms. Zeppelin and unanimously adopted by voice vote to move the P&E recommendations to the Executive Committee for approval.

EDUCATOR IN THE WORKPLACE

Ms. Mattick reported that the program was a success with a total of 11 teachers from a variety of school districts. Business hosts were BorgWarner, Taitem Engineering, Parkitects, Hiltronex, and Tetrattech,
