Maintain downtown cleanliness to a high standard

- Provide 7 days a week, 360 days a year supplemental service to the Commons and surrounding downtown area.
- Provide on-the-street/sidewalk visitor concierge service to at least 5,000 visitors each year.
- Provide the companion landscape maintenance service for Commons planters and surrounding downtown beds.

Clean Team Ambassadors

Clean Team Ambassadors were developed to offer:

- Supplemental cleaning of Downtown

- Year-round coverage; extra hours during peak season



Clean Team Ambassadors & Beautification

Ambassadors maintain:

- 18 in-ground Commons planters
- ~80 moveable Commons planters
- 16 above ground West State St planters

- On the street concierge service
- Referrals to Downtown Visitors Center
- Supplemental wayfinding
