

Registration by Mail -- Forms for Registration by mail may be obtained at the following offices: Board of Elections, Town Clerk, Village Clerk, Chamber of Commerce, Dept. of Motor Vehicles and other State Agencies providing services to the public.

Absentee Voting -- Civilians may qualify to vote by absentee ballot if their duties, occupation, or business requires them to be away from their county of residence, or if they are on vacation on the day of any Village Election. (Including spouse, parent or child accompanying such person).

Applications for absentee ballots to be mailed to the voter must be received by the Board of Elections no later than fifteen days before the election. If the applicant or his agent delivers the application to the Board of Elections in person, such application must be received no later than the day before the election. All absentee ballot envelopes must be post-marked no later than the day before the election.

**Calendar for Lansing Village Election
April 25, 2023**

Feb. 7	First day to sign independent nominating petitions.
Mar. 14-21	Dates for filing independent nominating petitions
Mar. 24	Last day to file certificate of acceptance or declination of an independent nomination.
Mar. 24 Apr. 14 May 22	Dates for filing statements of receipts and expenses for village elections, as per New York State Board of Elections Rules and Regulations.
Mar. 27	Last day to file certificate filling vacancy caused by declination of an independent nomination.
Apr. 14	Last day for voter to register with Board of Elections to vote in village election.
Apr. 10	Last day for Board of Elections to receive application for an absentee ballot to be mailed to a voter.
Apr. 24	Last day for applicant (or his agent) to personally deliver application for an absentee ballot to the Board of Elections.
Apr. 25	Election Day. Polls open 12 Noon to 9 p.m.
May 2	Last day for Board of Elections to certify results.
