

CRASH Summary for Tompkins County NY – 2018 data

The crash data for Tompkins County comes from the ALIS (Accident Location Information System) maintained by NYSDOT. Each Crash type discussed is represented by a Map at the bottom of this document.

- Of the 3,518 crashes in 2018:
 - **0.1%** (3) involved fatalities
 - **3%** (105) involved serious injuries
 - **1.4%** (50) involved a PEDESTRIAN
 - **0.6%** (22) involved a BICYCLIST
 - **16%** (574) involved a DEER
 - **13%** (446) occurred in a SNOW/ICE/SLUSH/FREEZING RAIN
 - **29%** (1,004) occurred on a DARK road
 - **12%** (419) involved a vehicle making a LEFT TURN
 - **12%** (430) involved a vehicle BACKING UP
 - **6%** (204) involved a vehicle making a RIGHT TURN
 - **38%** (2,302) involved a 4-Door Sedan
 - **34%** (2,051) involved an SUV / Suburban
 - **11%** (387) involved a driver 65+ years old
 - **9%** (300) involved a SPEED-RELATED crash
 - **2%** (66) involved an ALCOHOL-RELATED crash

FATAL CRASHES

	2018	2017	2016	2015	2008
Fatal Crashes (% of total crashes)	3 (0.1%)	7 (0.2%)	10 (0.3%)	12 (0.4%)	9 (0.3%)

- In 2017 and 2018, **50%** (5) of all fatal crashes were on State Roads and **40%** (4) were on County Roads. No fatal crashes occurred in the City of Ithaca in 2017 or 2018.
- Of the 10 fatalities in 2017 and 2018:
 - **50%** (5) occurred in DARK light conditions
 - **30%** (3) involved a Pedestrian or Bicyclist
 - **1** bicyclist was fatally injured by a vehicle making a LEFT TURN
 - **20%** (2) occurred on RAIN or SNOW road conditions
 - **20%** (2) result from Speed-Related Crash

SERIOUS INJURY CRASHES

- In 2018, **51%** (54) of all serious injury crashes were on State Roads and **24%** (25) were on County Roads. 20 serious injury crashes occurred in the City of Ithaca in 2018; 19 in 2017.
- Of the 105 serious injury crashes:
 - **21%** (22) result from LEFT TURN Crash
 - **18%** (19) result from Speed-Related Crash
 - **10%** (11) result from Alcohol-Related Crash
 - **16%** (17) result from **both** Speed-Related **and** Alcohol-Related in the same Crash
 - **11%** (11) involved a Pedestrian or Bicyclist
 - **82%** (9) of 11 result from a Pedestrian Crossing with no signal or crosswalk
 - **64%** (7) of 11 result from a Pedestrian Crossing in Dark conditions
 - **27%** (3) of 11 involved a vehicle making a LEFT TURN

DEER CRASHES

Deer Crashes (% of total crashes)	574 (16.3%)	548 (18.0%)	562 (16.6%)	834 (25.4%)	652 (19.1%)

- In T/Danby, **52%** of all crashes involved a Deer – In T/Groton, T/Ulysses and T/Newfield **38%**, in T/Enfield **34%**, in T/Dryden **31%**, in T/Lansing **28%**, and in T/Caroline **27%**.
- **60%** (344) of crashes involving a Deer occurred on State Roads – **26%** (149) on County Roads.
- **63%** (362) occurred in DARK or DUSK light conditions.
- **28%** (161) occurred on a WET/SNOW/ICE road condition.
- **2%** (12) resulted in a minor injury, **0%** in a serious injury or fatality

SNOW, SLUSH, ICE-RELATED CRASHES

- There were 446 crashes which occurring in SNOW, SLUSH, ICE conditions in 2018 (**13%** of total crashes).
- 17 of the 446 SNOW, SLUSH, ICE crashes resulted in a serious injury (**4%**) and none in a fatality (**0%**).

LEFT TURN CRASHES

- There were 419 crashes in which the collision involved a LEFT TURN in 2018 (**12%** of total crashes).
- 22 of the 419 LEFT TURN crashes resulted in a serious injury (**5%**) compared to **3%** in ALL Crashes. One LEFT TURN crash resulted in a fatality.
- 6 of the 419 LEFT TURN crashes involved a Bicyclist (**1%**) and 21 of the 419 LEFT TURN crashes involved a pedestrian (**5%**).
- 39 of 419 LEFT TURN crashes were in SNOW/ICE/FREEZING RAIN (**9%**).

PEDESTRIAN CRASHES

Pedestrian crashes (% of total crashes)	50 (1.1%)	19 (0.6%)	39 (1.1%)	34 (1.0%)	39 (1.1%)

- There were 50 crashes involving pedestrians in 2018 – a **63%** increase from 2017, when there were 19 crashes with pedestrians. From 2008-2018, the average number of crashes involving pedestrians was 36. We will continue to monitor this trend.
 - 10 of the 50 crashes with pedestrians resulted in a serious injury and 1 resulted in a fatality (**22%**) – compared to **3%** of ALL crashes resulting in a serious injury or fatality.
 - In 34 of the 50 pedestrian crashes (**68%**), the pedestrian's action was “crossing / no signal or marked crossing”, “crossing against signal, or “other actions in roadway”. 19 of these 50 (**38%**) occurred when the light condition was “dark-road lighted”, “dark-road unlighted”, or “dusk”.
 - In 9 of the 11 crashes involving serious injuries or fatality (**82%**), the pedestrian's action was “crossing / no signal or marked crossing”, “crossing against signal”, or “other actions in roadway”. 7 of these 11 (**64%**) occurred when the light condition was DARK or DUSK.
 - 42 of the 50 crashes involving pedestrians occurred in the City of Ithaca (**84%**). In 2017, 12 of the 19 crashes involving pedestrians occurred in the City of Ithaca (**63%**).
- **56%** (28) of crashes involving pedestrians occurred on City Streets. **30%** (15) occurred on State Roads.
- 21 of 50 crashes involving a pedestrian (**42%**) occurred when the vehicle was making a LEFT TURN.
 - 3 of these 21 LEFT TURN crashes resulted in a serious injury to the pedestrian (**14%**).

BICYCLE CRASHES

	2018	2017	2016	2015	2008
Bicyclist crashes (% of total crashes)	22 (0.6%)	23 (0.8%)	15 (0.4%)	24 (0.7%)	28 (0.8%)

- There were 22 crashes involving bicyclists in 2018 – a **5%** decrease from 2017.
 - 3 of these 22 crashes with bicyclists resulted in a serious injury or fatality (**14%**) – compared to **3%** of ALL crashes resulting in a serious injury or fatality.
 - In 7 of the 22 bicyclist crashes (**32%**), the bicyclist's action was “crossing / no signal or marked crossing”, “crossing against signal, “along highway against traffic”, or “other actions in roadway”. In all others, the bicyclist's action was “along highway with traffic” (recommended practice).
 - Only 4 of these 22 (**18%**) occurred when the light condition was “dark-road lighted”. All the others occurred in “daylight”.
 - In 2 of the 3 crashes involving serious injuries or fatality, the bicyclist's action was “crossing / no signal or marked crossing” or “other actions in roadway”. 1 of these 3 occurred when the light condition was “dark-road lighted”.
 - **73%** (16) of crashes involving bicyclists in 2017 and 2018 occurred on City Streets. **20%** (4) occurred on State Roads.
 - 6 of 22 crashes involving Bicyclists (27%) occurred when the vehicle was making a LEFT TURN.
 - 1 of these 6 LEFT TURN crashes resulted in a bicyclist fatality.

ALCOHOL-RELATED CRASHES


	2018
Alcohol-related crashes (% of total crashes)	66 (2%)

- 11 of the 66 crashes involving ALCOHOL resulted in a serious injury (**17%**). None resulted in a fatality.
- 17 of the 66 crashes involving ALCOHOL also involved SPEEDING (**26%**).
- One ALCOHOL-related crash involved a bicyclist and one involved a pedestrian.
- **40%** (26) of crashes involving ALCOHOL occurred on State Roads – **31%** (21) on County Roads.
- **78%** (52) of crashes occurred in DARK light conditions.
- **33%** (22) of crashes occurred when the road surface was WET, SNOW, or ICE.

SPEED-RELATED CRASHES

	2018
Speed-related crashes (% of total crashes)	300 (9.0%)

- 29 of 300 crashes involving SPEED resulted in a serious injury (**10%**). None resulted in a fatality.
- Two SPEED-related crashes involved a bicyclist and one involved a pedestrian.
- **40%** (120) of crashes involving SPEED occurred on State Roads – **31%** (93) on County Roads.
- **37%** (111) of crashes occurred in DARK or DUSK light conditions.
- **57%** (170) of crashes occurred when the road surface was WET, SNOW, ICE, or SLUSH.

All Fatal Crashes 2017 (7)


Location of Fatal Crashes in Tompkins County, NY 2017 and 2018




Location of Crashes involving Serious Injuries in Tompkins County NY 2018


Location of Crashes Involving a Deer in Tompkins County, NY 2017 and 2018




Location of Crashes in Snow, Slush or Ice in Tompkins County NY 2018




Location of Crashes

Crashes w/Bicyclists 2017 (23)




Location of Crashes Involving Alcohol in Tompkins County NY 2017 and 2018
