#### **Insights:**

Redistribution of resources

Focus on fairness and equity in practices

Increased accountability & training

Invest in current system to enhance abilities/meet capacity needs Address inconsistencies in policing practices

Limit role of police in various response situations



**Q4:** What challenges or concerns do you have with public safety practices, policies and procedures in Tompkins County based upon your or other experiences?

#### **Insights:**

Who is driving (or should drive) conversations? Public opinion and/or professional expertise?

Bias, racial profiling, & cultural insensitivity concerns

Inconsistent practices, and perceptions of practices: some argue there is overpolicing, some suggest under-staffing

Police responding to calls that could be handled by other professionals Hiring practices, employment arrangements, unions, and morale of departments

Law enforcement react rather than proactively prevent crime

### Insights:

Address culture of police departments & relationships with community

Consider different tools and how tools are used (incl. Demilitarization) Who else can respond to certain situations? What resources do they need?
