Project Description

Drug overdose is a major public health problem in the United States in general and specifically in Tompkins County. We have sports league members who died of drug overdose, and we know families in the county that have been affected by this epidemic. The majority of these deaths involved opioids, especially fentanyl and other synthetic opioids that can be mixed or laced with other drugs without the user's knowledge. We want to be part of the solution in addressing this crisis. Accordingly, we propose to implement a drug overdose education and prevention program in our community, targeting athletes of all sports especially young adults aged 17-34 who are at high risk of overdose. Our project aims to raise awareness and provide information about the risks and signs of drug overdose, as well as the actions that can be taken to prevent and respond to overdose situations for athletes in Tompkins County.
