

Registration by Mail -- Forms for Registration by mail may be obtained at the following offices: Board of Elections, Town Clerk, Village Clerk, Dept. of Motor Vehicles and other State Agencies providing services to the public.

Requesting a Ballot -- Voters may request a ballot by mail, either early vote by mail (no “reason”) or absentee ballot if their duties, occupation, or business requires them to be away from their county of residence, or if they are on vacation on the day of any Village Election.

Applications for early vote by mail or absentee ballots to be mailed to the voter must be received by the Board of Elections no later than ten days before the election. If the applicant or his agent delivers the application to the Board of Elections in person, such application must be received no later than the day before the election. All mail ballot envelopes must be postmarked no later than the day of the election.

Early Vote By Mail—Early Mail Voting Chapter 481 of the Laws of 2023 authorizes early mail voting. Known at the “New York Early Mail Voter Act,” this method of voting will be available to voters for all elections, including village elections conducted by the village clerk pursuant to Article 15 of the Election Law beginning on January 1, 2024. A registered voter of a village may vote by early mail ballot for any general or special village election in which he or she is eligible to vote, provided that such voter makes a written application. The process for early mail voting will largely mirror the procedure by which voters cast absentee ballots.

April 28, 2026***

Feb. 10	First day to sign independent nominating petitions.
Mar. 17-24	Dates for filing independent nominating petitions
Mar. 27	Last day to file certificate of acceptance or declination of an independent nomination.
Mar. 27 Apr. 17 May 25	Dates for filing statements of receipts and expenses for village elections, as per New York State Board of Elections Rules and Regulations.
Mar. 30	Last day to file certificate filling vacancy caused by declination of an independent nomination.
Apr. 17	Last day for voter to register with Board of Elections to vote in village election.
Apr. 17	Last day for Board of Elections to receive an application for a ballot to be mailed to a voter.
Apr. 27	Last day for applicant (or his agent) to personally deliver application for a mail ballot to the Board of Elections.
Apr. 28	Election Day. Polls open 12 Noon to 9 p.m.
May 5	Last day for Board of Elections to certify results.
