WHEREAS, Tompkins County is home to an active, growing, and civically engaged Hispanic community, and

WHEREAS, virtually every aspect of our community's life has been influenced by Hispanic people, whether in arts, medicine, government, labor, business, or volunteerism, and

WHEREAS, the Latino Civic Association of Tompkins County is celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month with a series of exciting family-friendly community events, and

WHEREAS, September 15th traditionally starts Hispanic Heritage Month because it is the anniversary of independence of five Latin American countries — Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Tompkins County Legislature, proclaims, recognizes, and designates the month spanning September 15th, 2025, through October 15th, 2025, as

HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

in Tompkins County.
