Tourism Program Overview

- Why does Tompkins County have a Tourism Program?
 - To maintain and enhance our county's appeal as a destination
 - To enhance quality of life for residents
 - To diversify and grow our local economy
- Strategic Tourism Plan defines values and goals for the County



Tourism Program Goals

- Increase average overnight trip length by one night from 2-3 nights to 3-4 nights.
- Increase average visitor spending by 5% from \$366 to \$384 per day in established downtowns and villages.
- Offer indoor and outdoor visitor programming year-round.
- ... plus others listed in the Strategic Tourism Plan







ELIGIBILITY

- 1.) Equipment lending priority is given to: Events free and open to the public and events occurring within the Business Improvement District (BID)
- 2.) Events must occur within Tompkins County.

PROCESS

- 1.) To make your equipment request, fill out this form in its entirety.
- 2.) Wait to be contacted by the DIA via info@downtownithaca.com. Generally, you will get a reply email within 5-7 business days of the request submission.
- 3.) Once details are established and agreed upon, you will receive a Request Approval Letter.
- 4.) You will then sign and return the approval letter, and make any appropriate payments. Please note, reservations are not final until the approval letter is returned signed and the appropriate payment is made.
- 5.) Pick-up and drop-off equipment within the agreed upon dates and times.

PRICING GUIDELINES

An administration fee (\$5.00 nonrefundable) will be charged to all users of the equipment lending library to cover the DIA's associated costs.

- 1.) Events that are free and open to public, and occur within the BID:

Weekday: pick-up \$25, drop-off \$25
Weekend: pick-up \$50, drop-off \$50

- 2.) Events that are not free and open to the public **OR** events that take place outside of the BID:


Weekday: pick-up \$50, drop-off \$50
Weekend: pick-up \$100, drop-off \$100

You are financially responsible for items broken or not returned and will be charged. A borrower's misuse of equipment, or disrespect for program rules and policies, will affect future rental approvals.

Tourism Capital Grants

- Purpose: to support major investments in visitor-generating projects
- Eligibility:
 - Nonprofit organizations & municipalities
 - Capital investments & feasibility studies
- Award range: \$5,000 to \$100,000 (\$250,000 available)
- Match: \$1 grant : \$2 other sources
- Application deadline: **TBD**

Community Celebrations

- Purpose: to support events that convey the unique culture and history of Tompkins County
- Eligibility:
 - Event is free and open to all
 - Event is an observance, jubilation, presentation, etc.
 - No carnival rides, fireworks, religious celebrations, etc.
- Award Range: \$500 - \$2,500 (\$16,850 available)
- Match: \$1 grant : \$1 other sources
- Application deadline: **February 26, 2026**



Tourism Advancement Grants

- Purpose: to attract visitors to Tompkins County for overnight trips
- Eligibility:
 - Nonprofit organizations & municipalities
 - Performances, festivals, guided tours, exhibits, and other events
 - No fundraisers, membership groups, faith congregations, or conferences
- Award range: \$2,500 to \$10,000 (\$85,000 available)
- Match: \$1 grant : \$1 other sources
- Application deadline: **February 26, 2026**



Tompkins Outdoors Grants


- Purpose: to enhance Tompkins County's reputation and profile as a leading outdoor recreation destination
- Eligibility:
 - Nonprofit organizations that manage natural areas or offer outdoor tours / programs
 - Other criteria in guidelines
- Award: up to \$19,000 (\$55,000 available)
- Eligibility questionnaire: February 10, 2026
- Application deadline: **February 26, 2026**

Tourism Grants - Award Decision Process



Award Decision Process

- County staff review applications (completeness and eligibility).
- Grant review committee evaluates applications and recommends funding to Strategic Tourism Planning Board.
- Tourism Board considers review committee's report and votes to submit recommended funding to Tompkins County Legislature (via Housing and Economic Development Committee).
- Legislature considers funding request and votes to authorize grant awards.
- County staff prepare and send contracts.

Key 2026 Dates

- January 28 Grant information session
- February 10 Eligibility questionnaire due for Tompkins Outdoors grant
- February 26 Application deadline
- March 18 STPB makes grant award recommendation
- April 1 HED Committee votes on grant resolutions
- April 21 County Legislature votes on grant resolutions
- April 22 and beyond Grant contracts issued and signed
- ... 30 days after your event or project completion – grant report due

Current Grant Programs

Applications are now open for our spring 2026 grant round! Three funding opportunities are available to support community vitality, visitor engagement, and outdoor recreation in Tompkins County:

- **Community Celebrations Grants** – Support local events that celebrate our unique culture and history
- **Tourism Advancement Grants** – Fund initiatives that attract overnight visitors to our area
- **Tompkins Outdoors Grants** – Strengthen organizations that enhance Tompkins County's reputation and profile as an outdoor recreation destination, with grants up to \$19,000 or 10% of organizational budget (whichever is less)






This grant funds community-led efforts to educate the public about our history and cultural inheritances; to improve understanding of local culture; and to expand contemporary culture in ways that are informative, educational and just plain fun.

A celebration is an event, program, or series of events endorsed by a municipality or recognized community. A celebration is also defined as an observance, commemoration, jubilation, inauguration, presentation, salute, or any other "red letter day" that has meaning for the community.

This grant is funded by Hotel Room Occupancy Tax collected in Tompkins County, NY. A total of \$36,590 was budgeted for this grant in 2019
