



# CORRECTIONS DIVISION POPULATION

Dear Undersheriff Olin:

We are **approving** your 2026 STOP DWI Plan. Thank you for submitting your Certification Page and Resolution or Approved Budget pages, and for your dedication and continued work to address the problem of impaired driving.

Commissioners Rules and Regulations section 172.3 (c), states that “Approval of a plan by the commissioner will be made only after prior approval and documented endorsement of the plan by the local governing body. Documentation of endorsement is to be in the form of a copy of the local resolution adopting the plan and authorizing expenditures after approval of the plan by the commissioner.”

NY CRR Section 172.3(e) states that a “written notification of all plan amendments and budget modifications which propose either expenditures in previously unfunded areas or items or increased expenditures in previously funded areas or items must be sent to the commissioner. In the case of previously unfunded areas or items, such notifications must be sent at least 15 days prior to the expenditure. Written approval by the commissioner is required of such budget modifications only if the sum total of all budget modifications within a fiscal year exceeds 10 percent of the originally approved budget.”

We recognize that county governments continue to experience the same fiscal constraints as the rest of the state. In these difficult times, we have a duty to ensure that program spending is constrained to activities that prevent impaired driving, including the enforcement of impaired driving laws, and is not used to supplant local expenses. If you plan to modify this STOP DWI budget plan, you must notify the GTSC (Governor’s Traffic Safety Committee) before incurring any costs.
