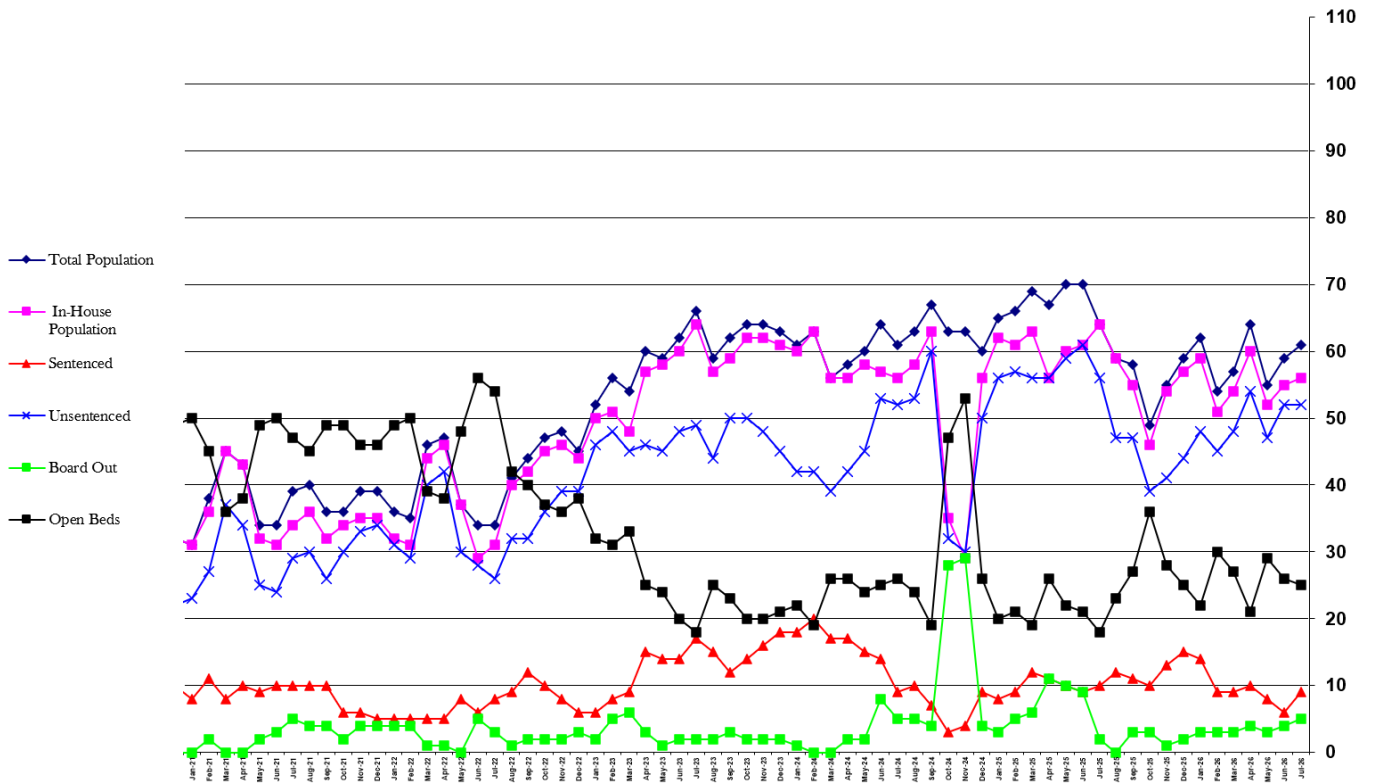

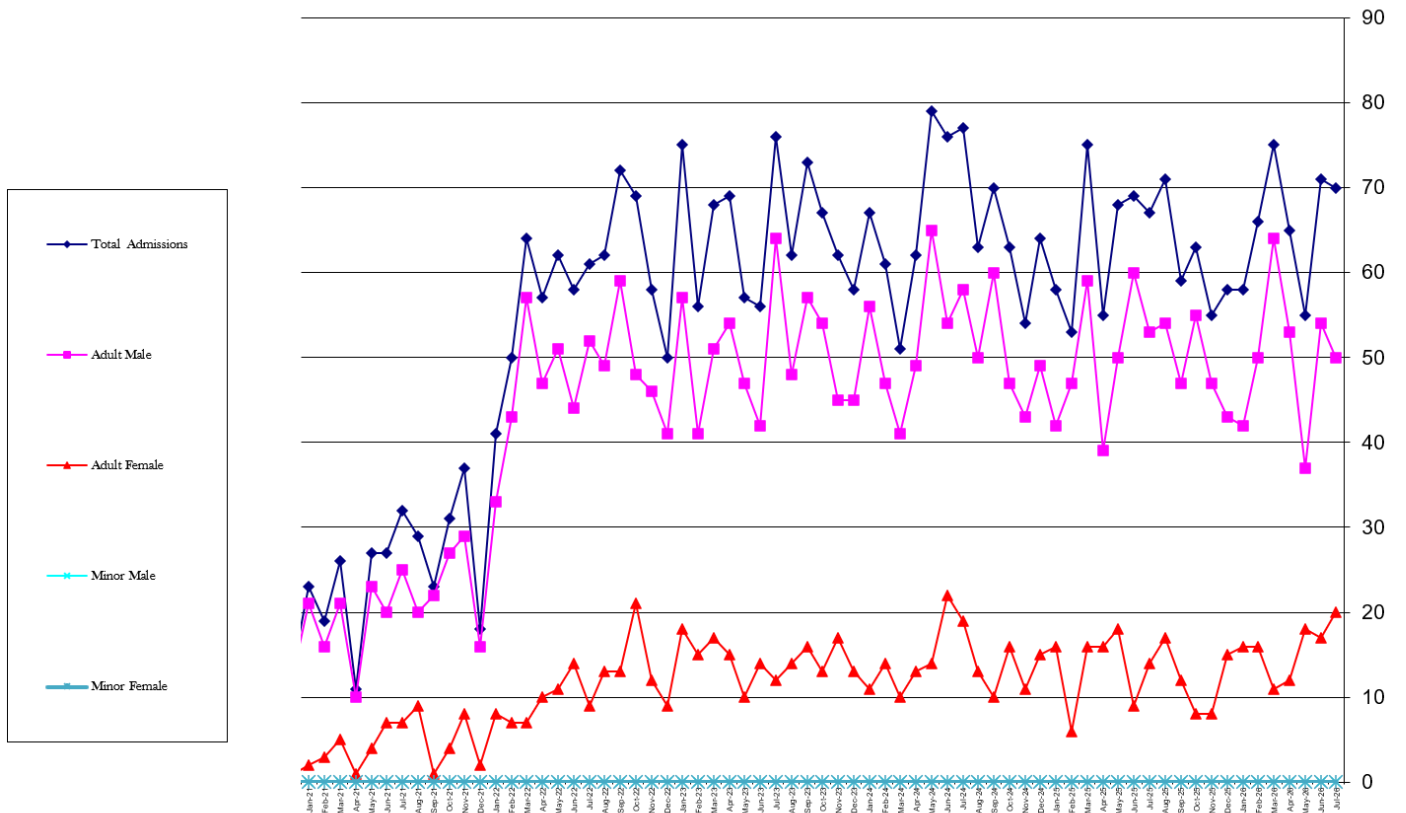

Average Jail Statistics

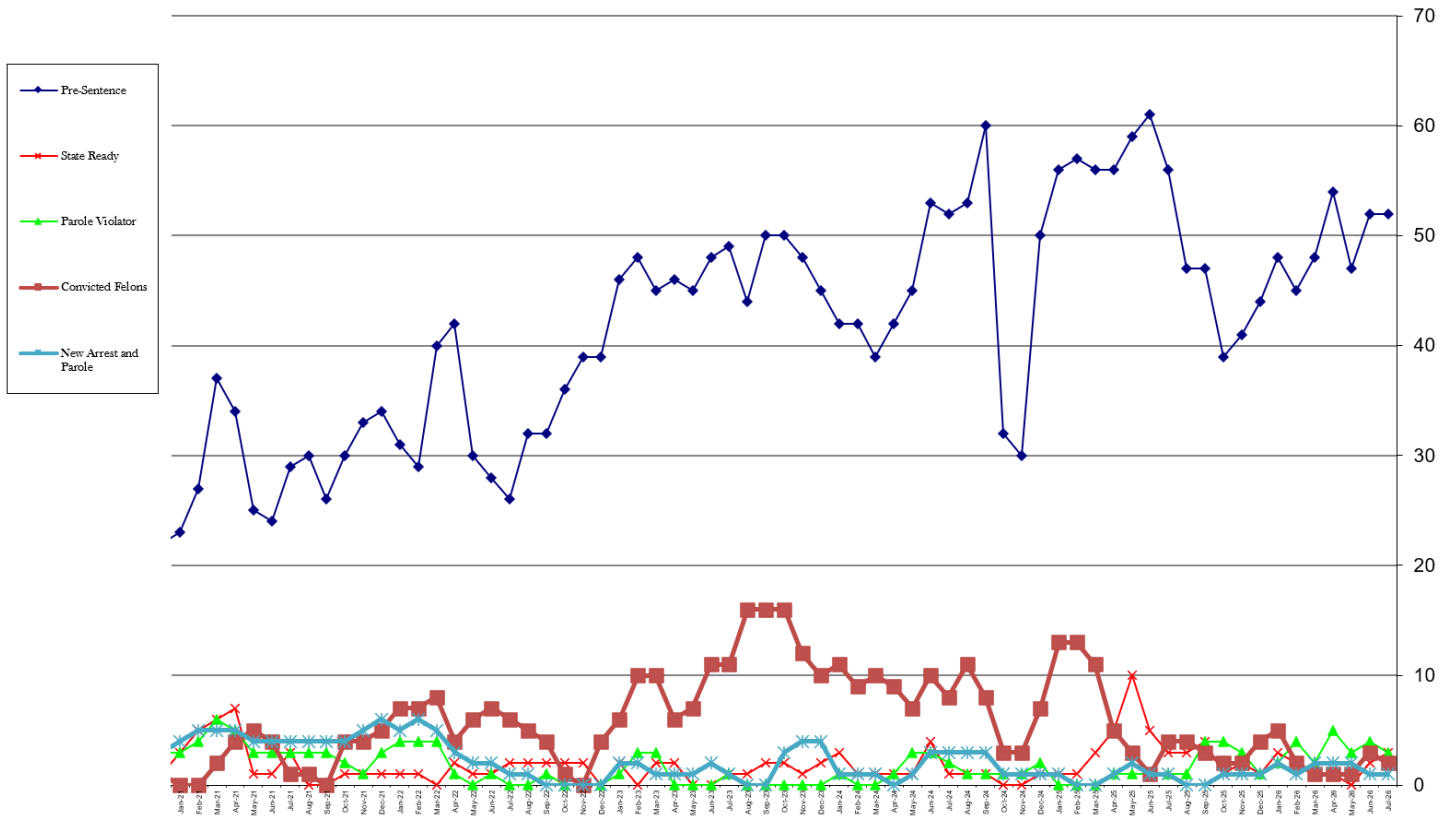


Monthly Admission Totals

Activities

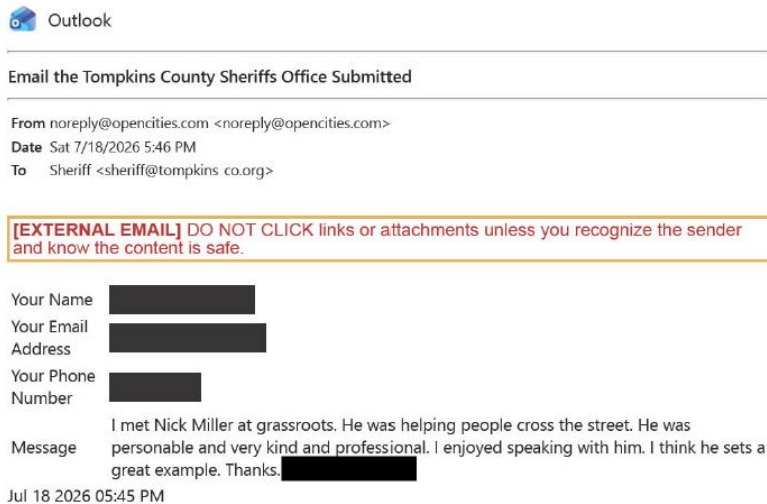
- July 2nd – 5th: TCSO and other local law enforcement agencies participated in the July 4th Weekend High Visibility Engagement Campaign
