- Daytime warming center with case management services: 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Nighttime shelter: 4 p.m. to 8 a.m.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Well-trained, experienced staff providing 24/7 coverage and security, including weekends, evenings, and overnight.
- Meals provided on-site
- Transportation services to bring guests safely to the shelter and to appointments or other service locations for additional resources.
