

# 3rd Annual Tompkins County Election Sticker Design Contest

Submissions due May 26, 2025

## Grades K-5 “FutureVoter” Contest

“Future Voter” submissions must be submitted from a template provided by the County and must also be original artwork and may be hand drawn or created using a computer.

The “Future Voter” sticker template can be downloaded at [tcgov.co/2025futurevoter](https://tcgov.co/2025futurevoter). Printed copies are available at the Board of Elections, 128 E. Buffalo St. in Ithaca.

The “Future Voter” sticker that receives the most votes will be printed and distributed to young people joining their families at the polls.

Designs must have a local theme and include the colors red, white, and blue.

After all submissions are received, Tompkins County Board of Elections Staff will select up to six finalists in each contest for voting by the entire community.

## Grades 6-12 “I Voted” Contest

For the “I Voted” sticker contest, the submitted artwork must say “I Voted” somewhere visible and must fit in a 1.5-inch by 2.5-inch rectangle.

Submissions must be original artwork and may be hand drawn or created using a computer.

The “I Voted” sticker that receives the most votes from Tompkins County residents will be printed and distributed to all voters in the November 2025 general election.
