Must be a registered voter in Tompkins County
(or pre-registered if 17 years old).

Must be willing to represent either the Democratic or Republican Party.

Must be a people person and enjoy serving others.

Additional Preferences:

To maintain the required party balance at polling places, we have a particular need for enrolled Republicans, as well as non-affiliated (independent) voters who are willing to serve as Republican representatives on Election Day (without changing their party registration).

Applicants of all political affiliations are encouraged to apply; assignments are made based on current staffing needs and party-balance requirements. Candidates should be available for placement anywhere within Tompkins County, as needed.
