a. Reimagining Public Safety

b. LEAD

Arrest Diversionresponding police officer will divert arrest to LEAD program if eligible, then contact REACH case management, and. 2. Social Contact Referral- someone will refer the person who is eligible. Will have a press conference to officially launch by the end of September.

c. Criminal Justice Reform

Laurie Miller, CIPA- the students will be back in a week, they would like to get feedback about their work and how it could be expanded and more helpful. It was suggested that the students have actual training on context, framework and cultural sensitivity. d. Long Term Inmate Report

Matt Van Houten- Six people on the list- one parole violation, one waiting for a trial date, one waiting for a sentencing date, two waiting for trial dates pending psychiatric defense proceedings, one was to have a trial date 2-3 weeks ago and ran out of jurors, which means it was a mistrial and now is scheduled for January of 2022.
