Mr. Stitley- Radio Redundancy Shared Services

While working on the back-up center project, Mr. Stitley realized there may be opportunity to share radio infrastructure. We could see a significant cost savings by sharing the cost of radio systems with surrounding counties. Some systems can cost up to \$800,000. Mike would like to be involved in further discussions on shared services. This would be more appropriate for the 2023 shared services discussion.
