

PROGRESSIVE SWIMMING INSTRUCTOR for NYS Children's Camps

Fact Sheet – March 2024

A progressive swimming instructor is required to assess the swimming ability of each camper prior to allowing the child to participate in aquatic activities.

Note: A progressive swimming instructor may not perform lifeguard duties unless currently certified as a qualified lifeguard (see "[Aquatic Certifications](#)" fact sheet) and the individual is not concurrently performing instructional duties.

The following courses meet the certification requirements as specified in Section 7-2.5(f) of [Subpart 7-2](#) of the New York State Sanitary Code:
