Win a Lowes gift card

All owners who register one or more smoke-free apartment buildings before August 31, 2009 will be entered into a drawing for a \$200 gift card from Lowes Home Improvement Center.*

The first 16 property owners who register one or more multi-unit dwellings as a smoke-free apartment will be eligible to receive a \$50 gift card from Lowes Home Improvement Center. A registration form is enclosed. Registrations must be signed and may be submitted by mail or fax. Limit one \$50 gift card per property owner(s).

Free Signs

Sufficient signage is an important part of effective compliance with a smoke-free apartment policy or lease. Landlords who register properties as smoke-free are eligible for free T-Free Zone signs from Tobacco Free Tompkins. The T-Free Zone logo is used by TCAT, a number of government offices, Titus Towers, The Shops at Ithaca Mall, the Sciencenter, and countless other businesses and workplaces throughout Tompkins County. As such, it is increasingly recognized for designating smoke-free areas.

Free Listing

An online directory of local smoke-free rental housing is maintained by Tobacco Free Tompkins. There is no charge to be included.

Visit www.tompkins-co.org/tobaccofree, and click on the 'Smoke-free Apartments' link. The directory was launched in mid-March 2009, and to date, over 40 properties are listed by eight property owners.

^{*}A smoke-free apartment building means, at minimum, that all dwelling units within the building are rented/leased/occupied as no smoking anywhere within the dwelling unit. Applies to tenant, all household members, all guests & visitors; all dwelling units vacant, tenant occupied, owner occupied; all service, maintenance and construction personnel. All indoor common areas are smoke-free under the Clean Indoor Air Act of 2003.
