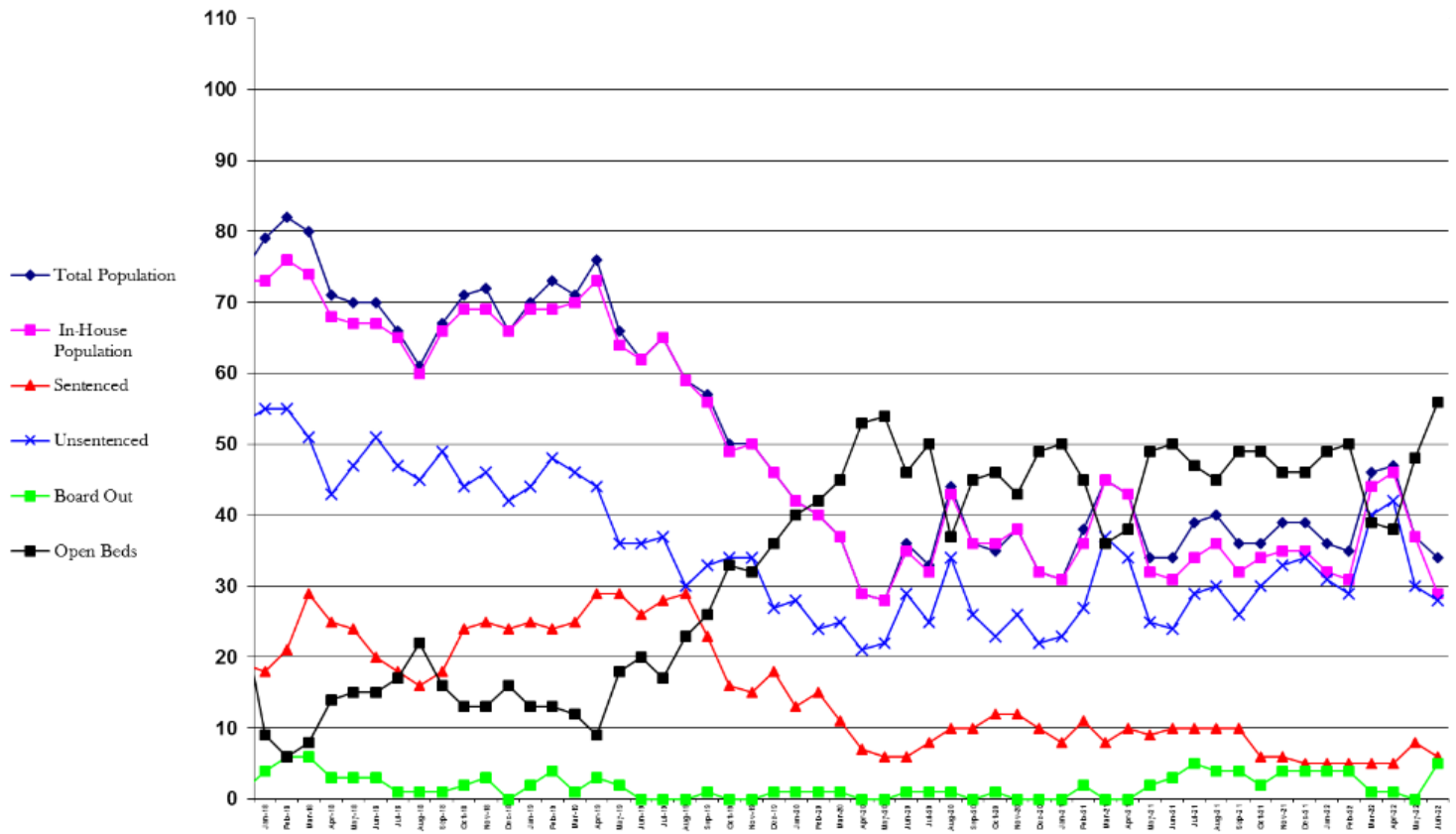

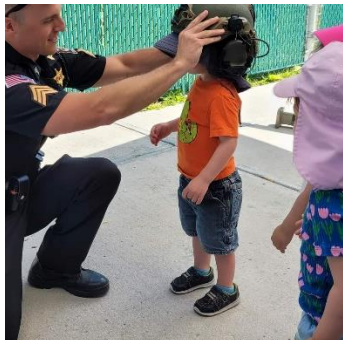


## ACTIVITIES CONTINUED


I wanted to thank you for allowing your staff to speak to the TST-BOCES Criminal Justice Class.
