Every year, the U. S. Census Bureau collects data from 1 in 40 households – including the following questions:


- "At what location did this person work last week?" (name, address, county, zip code)
- "How did this person usually get to work?" (most of the distance)


This sample data is taken every year and summarized every 5 years. The latest data we have for Tompkins County is 2026 5 (2012-2016 ACS). The 5 year samples equal, approximately, 1 in 8 households surveyed.

ITCTC accessed journey-to-work (Origin-Destination) data for the 23 Census Tracts within Tompkins County along with data for the Census Tracts in the 6 adjacent counties (Seneca, Cayuga, Cortland, Tioga, Chemung, and Schuyler). The following pages show the results of this analysis – focusing on "Drive Alone" journey-to-work trips FROM (where the workers drove alone from) and TO (where the residents drove alone to) – for each of the 23 Census Tracts in Tompkins County, NY (including trips to and from adjacent counties).

Below each Census Tract "pie chart", we list "data highlights" – key information we learned from the data. The last bullet at the bottom lists the percentages of the other modes to and from work for that Census Tract (carpool, bus, walk, bicycle, taxi, worked at home).


On the page following this description, you can see the extent of each Census Tract (see map below). ITCTC named the Census Tracts for the purpose of the report. For example, Census Tract 18 called "Newfield" actually contains most of the Town of Newfield, a small portion of the Town of Enfield, and some of the Town of Danby. There is no data available for each municipality, only for each Census Tract.
















