Discussion:

- How to increase support for rural ambulance/EMS service in rural New York.
- Constraint for rural municipalities is that call numbers/demand are not sufficient to support paid service.
- Trumansburg and Dryden ambulance have been compelled to expand their coverage to adjoining rural areas, where response times are then longer.
- Is developing a non-profit ambulance service a viable option?
- Can we develop career EMT positions for rural localities? This is ultimately a local political decision.
- What additional support we can develop for existing volunteers? Paid staff?
- Paramedics and EMTs typically cannot be retained because of low wages of these positions.
- Outcomes for June 5 meeting:
 - key points for recommendations to TCCOG for a resolution to NYS legislature for increased funding for paid staff for rural emergency medical services. Suggestion for increase in medicaid reimbursement rate for ambulance services. CHIPS or Transit Authority model?
 - Training/Consultation for TCCOG by Brad Pinsky (Fire Protection Contracts, rural EMS) find out what he could offer and recommend and what it would cost.
